When we **compare** two things, we tell how they are **alike**.
When we **contrast** two things, we tell how they are **different**.

1. **Read or listen to the story. As you do, think about how Jenna the Giraffe and Benny the Bird are alike and different.**

Jenna the Giraffe and Benny the Bird are best friends. Some people think it is funny that they are friends because they look so different! Jenna the Giraffe is very tall. She can see above all the other animals. Benny the Bird is very small! If he stands on the ground, he can barely see above the grass.

Jenna and Benny are best friends for a reason. They like to play the same games! Their favorite game is Tag. They like to play this together because they can both move very quickly. Jenna the Giraffe can run quickly.

Benny the Bird can fly quickly! They have fun running and flying as they try to catch each other.
