When you **make a prediction**, you use clues to guess what happens next.

1. Read or listen to the short story.

Ella was riding her bike down the street when she heard a loud clap of thunder. Clouds started rolling in quickly, and everything got dark. All of a sudden, she felt raindrops on her arms.

**Then make a prediction! What do you think happened next?
Circle one picture and describe why you chose it.**

3. Read or listen to the short story.

Emily was flying her new kite on a windy day. Her kite was high in the air. Suddenly, the wind stopped blowing, and her kite started to wobble back and forth.

Tell the rest of the story.

4. Read or listen to the short story.

Benji was walking his dog when he spotted a squirrel running up a tree. His dog saw it too.

Then make a prediction! What do you think happened next?
Tell the rest of the story.



Answers

1. Ella stopped and turned around, pedaling quickly toward her house.
2. Lucas jumped up and ran into the kitchen to grab a towel. He mopped up the water as quickly as he could!
3. *Accept any reasonable answer, such as, Emily's kite fell down.*
4. *Accept any reasonable answer, such as, Benji's dog started barking!*
