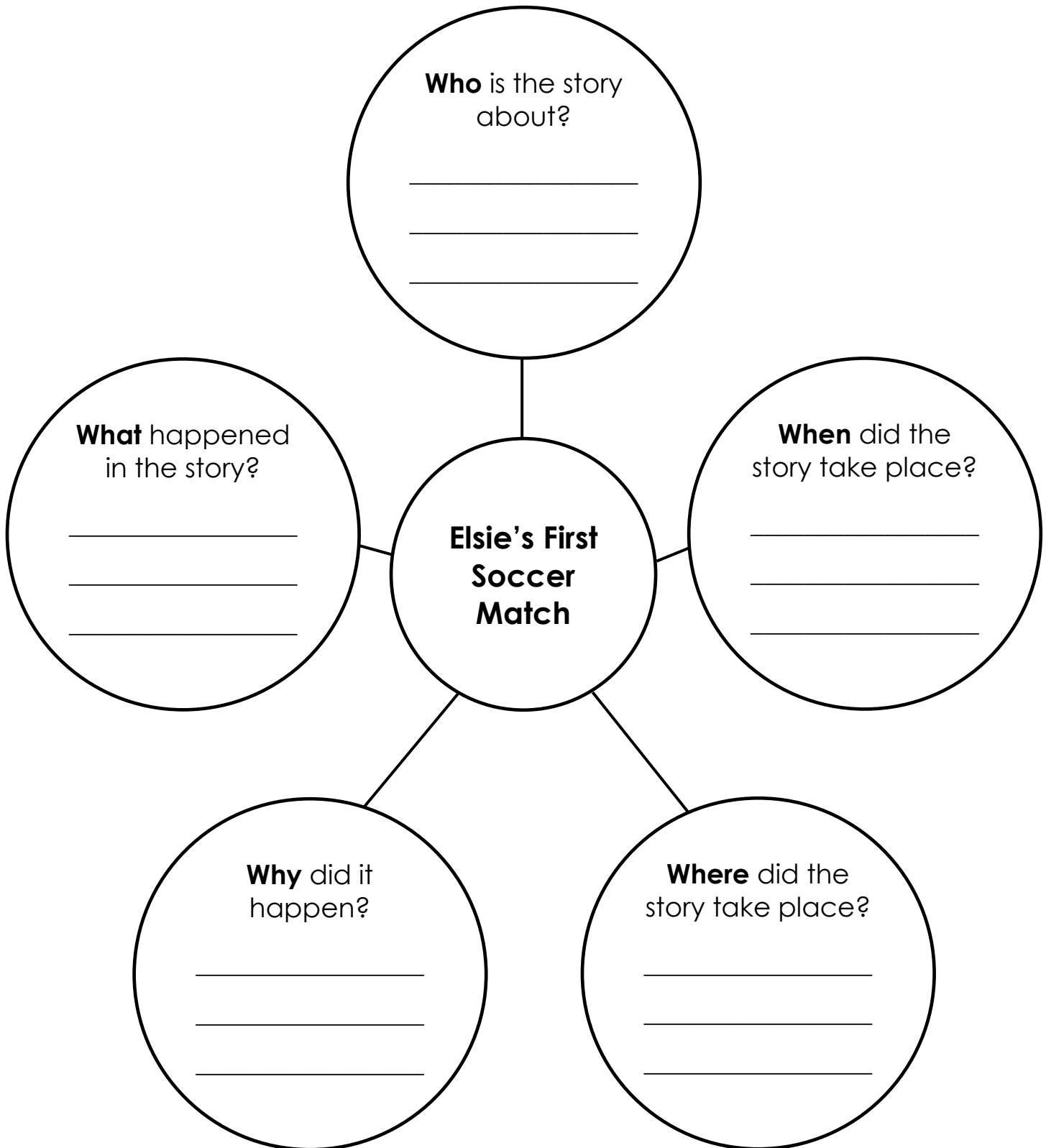
“Nice kick!” one of her teammates said. Elsie felt proud of herself.
