Below is the beginning of an essay about **pet-sitting**. Read the essay's introduction and three body paragraphs. Then write the essay's conclusion.

A **conclusion paragraph** should summarize your essay's main points and end with a creative or impactful sentence that wraps up your essay!

Introduction:
