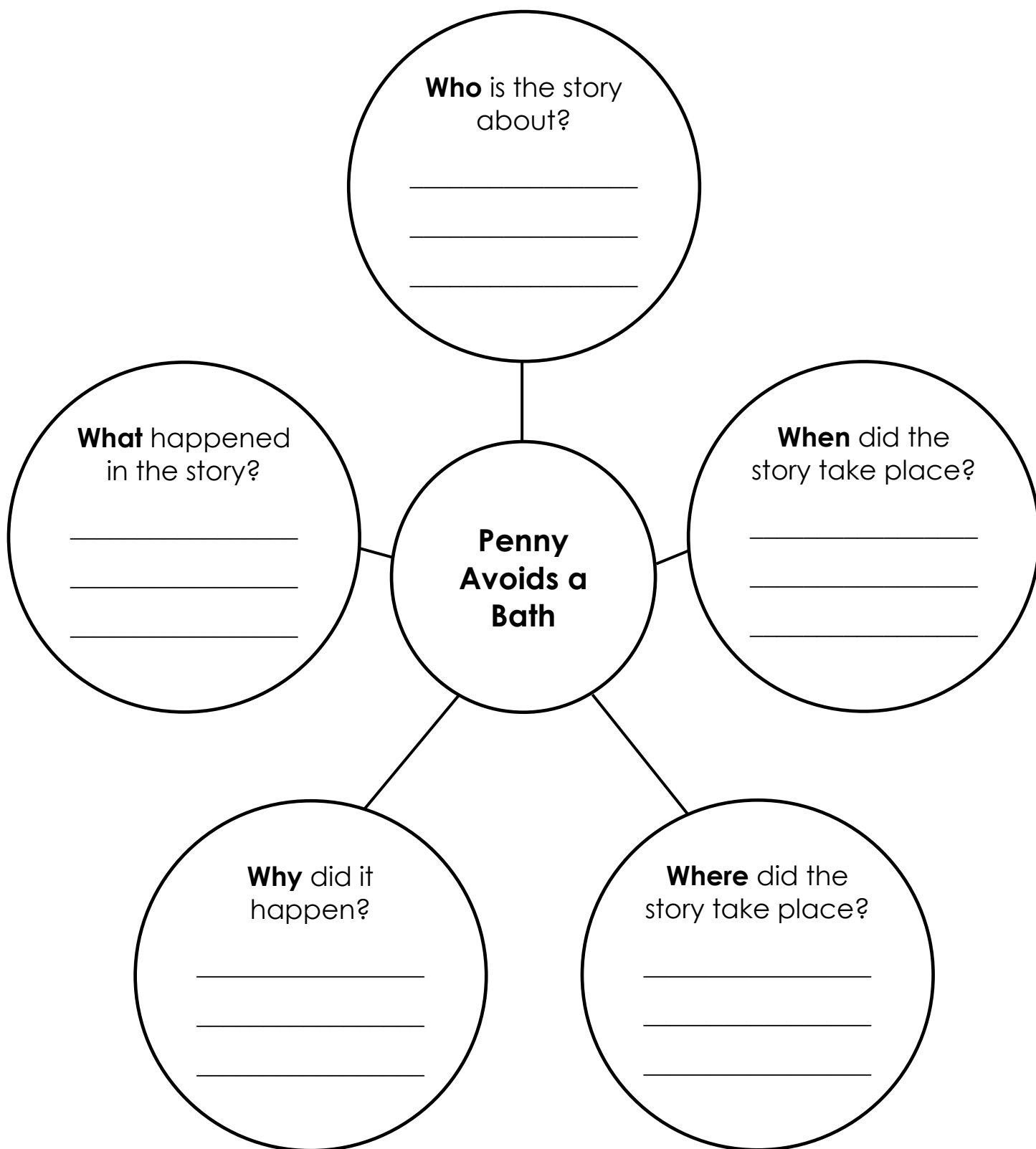
"Come back, Penny!" her owner called, laughing.
