

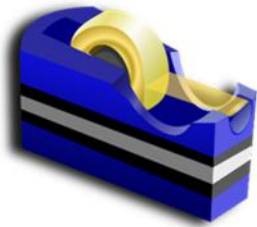


Metric units of weight: grams (g) and kilograms (kg)
