$$5) \quad 10 \frac{2}{12} + \frac{4}{12} = 10 \frac{1}{2}$$

$$6) \quad 9 \frac{2}{50} + \frac{8}{50} = 9 \frac{1}{5}$$

$$7) \quad 8 \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} = 9$$

$$8) \quad 3 \frac{12}{25} + \frac{2}{25} = 3 \frac{14}{25}$$

$$9) \quad 8 \frac{7}{16} + \frac{5}{16} = 8 \frac{3}{4}$$

$$10) \quad 6 \frac{5}{15} + \frac{2}{15} = 6 \frac{7}{15}$$

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$$16) \quad 8 \frac{1}{11} + \frac{9}{11} = 8 \frac{10}{11}$$

$$17) \quad 7 \frac{10}{15} + \frac{3}{15} = 7 \frac{13}{15}$$
