Grade 2 Phonics Worksheet

Read the story. Underline the long vowel sounds and circle their silent "e".

When an **e** is added to the end of a word, the vowel usually becomes long.



For instance:

cap → cape



Cole's Shoes

Someone took Cole's shoes! They were in his closet but now they are gone. Have you seen them?

He has had them since he was five. They were the color blue. He had spilled grape juice on one of them, so they smelled good! Cole liked to run in them and then glide on the floor. Cole doesn't want other shoes. He will be wearing just his socks until he can find them.
