Grade 1 Reading Worksheet

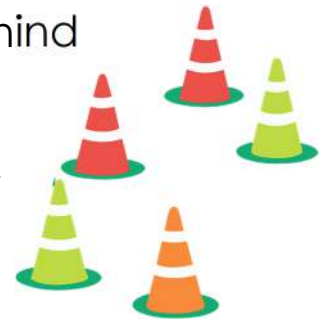


Characters are who the story is about.
