4. Dan was coughing a lot. *(because)*
Dan was coughing a lot because he had a bad cold.
5. The man ploughed the driveway. *(while)*
The man ploughed the driveway while his son shoveled the stairs.
6. The dog licked the bowl. *(until)*
The dog licked the bowl until all the food had disappeared.
7. We will make supper. *(after)*
We will make supper after you finish your homework.
8. We will cancel our cable subscription. *(unless)*
We will cancel our cable subscription unless you think we really need it.
