Grade 3 Math Word Problems Worksheet

1. Karen has 639 crayons. Cindy has 504 crayons. How many more crayons does Karen have than Cindy?
2. Jose has 85 peanuts. Kenya has 48 more than Jose. How many peanuts does Kenya have?
3. Lizette has 84 stamps. She has three times as many stamps as Minerva. How many stamps does Minerva have?





4. White t-shirts can be purchased in packages of 6. If Mom buys 71 packages, how many white t-shirts will she have?
5. I have 648 pencils. If I put 4 pencils in each pencil box, how many pencil boxes will I fill?
6. Uncle Dave bought 143 ice cream sandwiches. If he wants to give them to his 11 hungry nieces, how many can each niece get?



Answers

1. $639 - 504 = 135$
Karen has 135 more.
2. $85 + 48 = 133$
She has 133 peanuts.
3. $84 \div 3 = 28$
Minerva has 688 stamps.
4. $6 \times 71 = 426$
She will have 426 t-shirts.
5. $648 \div 4 = 162$
You will fill 162 pencil boxes.
6. $143 \div 11 = 13$
Each gets 13 ice cream sandwiches.
