Answers

Answers will vary. Here are samples of possible answers:

1. She will take you to the mall. *(although)*
She will take you to the mall **although** it is late.
2. You must shower. *(before)*
You must shower **before** you get dressed.
3. He will try it your way. *(even though)*
He will try it your way **even though** he is not sure it will work.
4. They need to practice every day. *(if)*
They need to practice every day **if** they want to enter the competition.
5. They will eat their dinner. *(once)*
They will eat their dinner **once** everyone is sitting down.
6. He emptied the garbage. *(after)*
He emptied the garbage **after** his dad asked him to.
