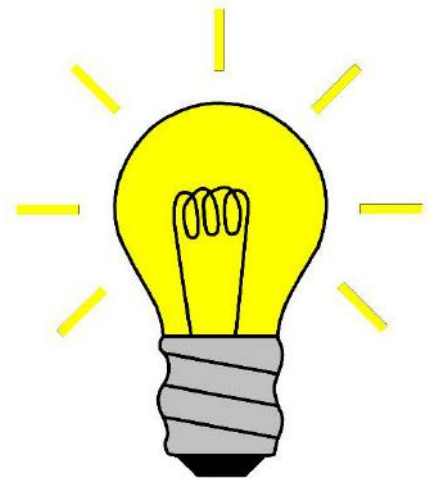
1. My **pillow** / **pillows** are pink.
