



Mixed practice word problems

Grade 3 Math Word Problems Worksheet

1. Ellen had 380 legos, but she lost 57 of them. How many legos does she have now?
2. Arthur baked 35 muffins. How many more muffins does Arthur have to bake to have 83 muffins?
3. Willy has 1,400 crayons. Lucy has 290 crayons. Jacob has 7 crayons. How many more crayons do they have altogether?





- There are 10 stickers on a page. If you have 22 pages of stickers, how many stickers do you have?
- If you lose one of the pages, then how many stickers would you have?
- There are 96 cupcakes for 8 children to share. How much will each person get if they share the cupcakes equally?



Answers

1. $380 - 57 = 323$
She now has 323.
2. $83 - 35 = 48$
He has to bake 48 more.
3. $1,400 + 290 + 7 = 1,697$
They have 1,697 crayons altogether.
4. $10 \times 22 = 220$
You have 220 stickers initially.
5. If you lose a page, then you have:
 $22 - 1 = 21$ pages
and
 $10 \times 21 = 210$ stickers.
6. $96 \div 8 = 12$
Each child gets 12 cupcakes.
