The air smelled like hay mixed with the scent of cows and sheep. The muddy ground felt squishy under her shoes, and she took a big jump to avoid a puddle!

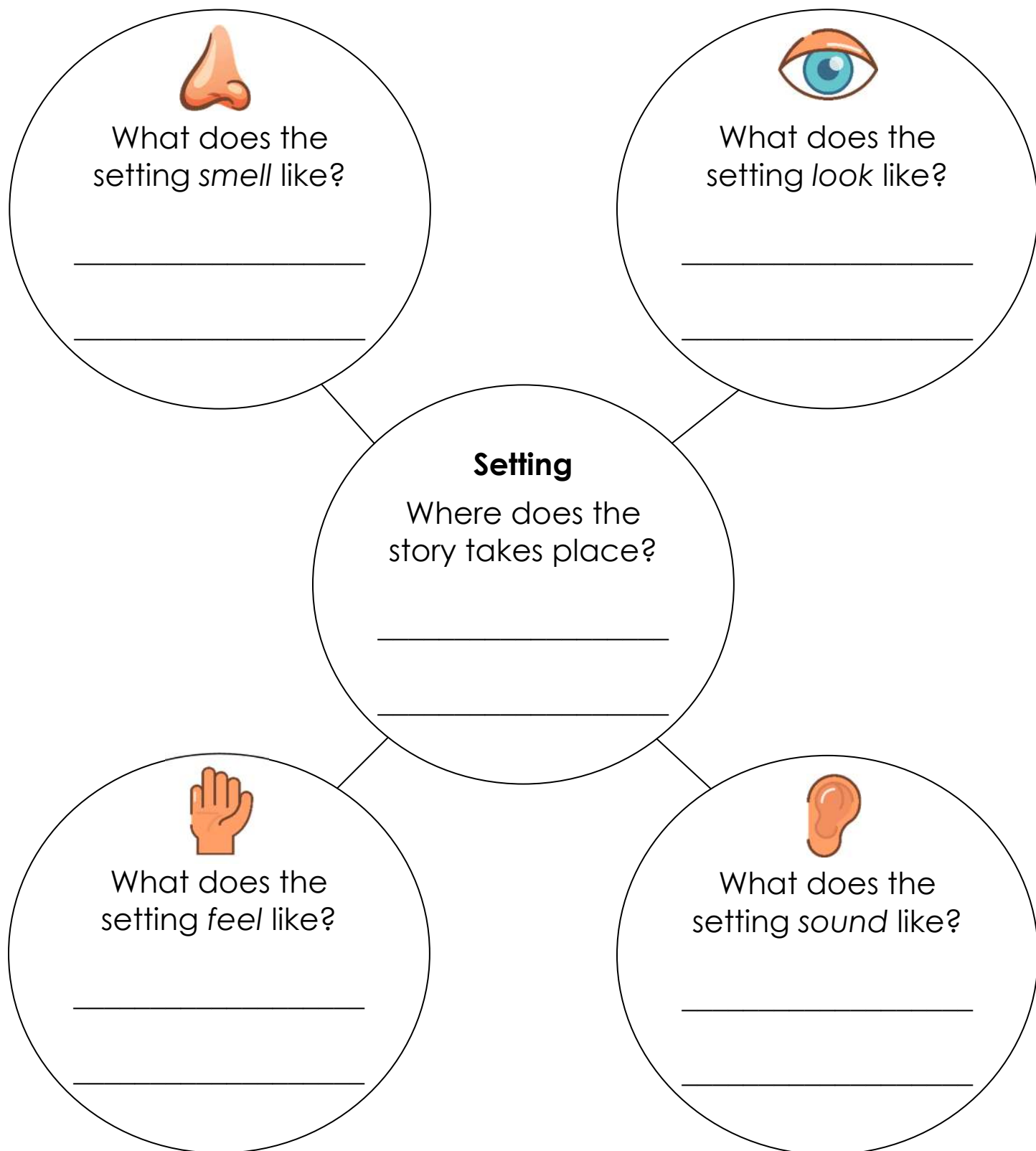
Emma could hear the clucking of chickens, the mooing of cows and the buzzing of bees. She even heard a rooster crowing!
